Diamond H Saddle Club Meeting/Trip



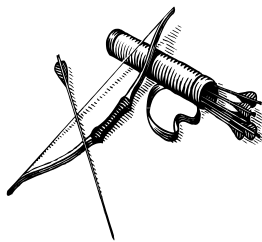
Saturday, March 11th, 9:00am, Bath Co. Ext. Office Large Conference Room
