# BATH COUNTY PRODUCE AUCTION

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

2019

ALL ITEMS BROUGHT TO THE AUCTION MUST SELL. THERE WILL BE NO NO-SALES  
NESTING OF POOR QUALITY PRODUCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND RECOURSE WILL BE BACK TO THE SELLER  
PRODUCE NOT GROWN BY THE CONSIGNER WILL BE SOLD LAST

LARGE LOTS WILL BE SOLD FIRST. Large lots are defined as:

- 4 or more boxes (peck size or larger)
- 4 or more flats
- 4 or more 5 dozen bags of sweet corn
- 1 bin

MEDIUM SIZE LOTS WILL SELL SECOND. Medium lots are defined as:

- 2 or 3 boxes (peck size or larger)
  - 2 or 3 flats
  - 2 or 3 5 dozen bags of sweet corn
- Medium lots will be sold 2 or more X money (bid).

SMALL SIZE LOTS/QUANTITIES: Will include ½ peck boxes - will be placed on carts/tables with sale prices attached and can be bought at any time for that price through the auction. Any items remaining on the table at the end of the Medium Size lots will be auctioned to the highest bidder.

Due to National Food Safety concerns, all produce sold at the auction must be packaged in an appropriate produce container. **THERE WILL BE NO REUSING OF CONTAINERS.** Containers can be bought from the Bath County Produce Auction management or the extension office during regular business hours. The produce auction management reserves the right to not sell any produce determined to be poor quality or not packaged properly. Quart containers are reserved for Berries, Cherry Tomatoes, Small Peppers, Nuts and Baby Potatoes. Each seller will be assigned a number for selling. That number is good for buying or selling. There will be absolutely no trading of produce on Auction Nights unless it is being sold through the Auction on Auction Grounds (Free or For Sale) No samples, No pets or Tobacco use on the Auction Floor.

- Peck Baskets – ½ Peck Baskets – 24 Inch Bins – 1 and 5 Dozen Sweet Corn Bags – Pint Berry and Stacker Boxes
- Quart Berry and Stacker Boxes
