All produce must be on the grounds by 15 minutes before sale time unless arrangements have been made with the management. No produce can be delivered to the auction before 3:00 pm on Thursday. Market Pavillion

Due to National Food Safety concerns, all produce sold at the auction must be packaged in an appropriate produce container. THERE WILL BE NO REUSING OF BOXES or CONTAINERS. Containers can be bought from the Bath County Produce Auction management or the extension office during regular business hours.

The produce auction management reserves the right to not sell any produce determined to be poor quality or not packaged properly.

Quart containers are reserved for Berries, Cherry Tomatoes, Small Peppers, Nuts and Baby Potatoes.

Each seller will be assigned a number for selling. That number is good for buying or selling.

There will be absolutely no trading of produce on Auction Nights unless it is being sold through the Auction on Auction Grounds (Free or For Sale) No samples, No pets or Tobacco use on the Auction Floor.
