
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












Crunchy Air Fryer Fish

Prep time: 10 minutes Rest 10 minutes

Cook time: 10-15 minutes

- 1 pound of white fish fillets (tilapia, catfish, perch, etc.)
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika
- 1/4 teaspoon chili powder
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 cup panko crumbs
- Nonstick cooking spray
- Wash hands with warm water and soap, scrubbing for at least 20 seconds.
- 2. Place fish between clean paper towels to allow any water to drain. Rewash hands after handling raw fish.
- **3.** Create an assembly for coating the fish. First, in a small bowl, combine the garlic powder, paprika, chili powder, onion powder, black pepper, and salt; set aside. Then, in a shallow pan or plate, whisk the egg; set aside. Rewash hands after handling the raw egg. Place panko crumbs into another shallow pan or plate; set aside.
- 4. Coat fish on both sides with olive oil and sprinkle both sides with the seasoning mixture. Dip fish into the egg and coat both sides. Then dredge the fillets through the panko coating both sides thoroughly. Allow the coated fillets to rest about 10 minutes before cooking. Rewash hands after handling the raw fish.
- **5.** Preheat the air fryer to 390 degrees F while the fish rests. Coat the

preheated air fryer basket or pan with cooking spray. Add the fish, taking care not to overfill the basket or pan (you may need to work in batches). Cook for 10 to 13 minutes or until it reaches an internal temperature of 145 degrees F as measured on a meat thermometer.

6. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours. Reheat leftovers in the air fryer for a few minutes to revive the crunchy coating.

No air fryer? No problem. Simply bake these in the oven at 400 degrees F for 12 to 15 minutes or until they reach an internal temperature of 145 degrees F as measured on a meat thermometer.

- Registration packets MUST be returned by May 30th.
- Registration packets received on or before May 2nd will be eligible for scholarships.
- Payment is due June 20th via cash or check. Payments may be made incrementally.
- All campers are required to attend Camp Orientation at the Extension Office on June 16th. More info to come.
- A limited number of scholarships are available.
- Bath County attends camp with Greenup, Boyd, Carter,
 Gallatin, and Carroll Counties this year.
- The Kentucky 4-H Camping Program is American Camp Association accredited.
- Adult Volunteers are needed to help with 4-H Camp. If you are willing to attend, please contact the Bath County Extension Office.
- All Camp Volunteers must be screened through the Client Protection Process, which includes an interview, background check, child abuse and neglect check, and reference checks.
- Students 16-18 who are interested in attending 4-H Camp should contact the Extension Office for a Counselor Application by May 2nd.









Scholarship Information:

Thank you for your interest in sending your child to 4-H Camp! The cost of 4-H Camp is \$325 for youth who have either turned 9 by the first day of camp (June 30, 2025) or will be entering 4th grade in August of 2025. We do not want money to be a barrier for your child to attend, so we are offering scholarships to aid parents in paying for 4-H Camp. Please note that a \$25 deposit is required to hold your student's spot.

- Scholarship applications will be sent with registration packets.
- Full and partial scholarships may be offered.
- To be eligible for scholarships, registration packets and scholarship applications must be returned to the Bath County Extension Office by May 2nd.
- Scholarship decisions will be communicated to parents by May 15th.
